The **2014 USS Muliphen AKA-61** reunion will be held **April 30 – 04 May** at the **Hutchinson Island Plaza Hotel & Suites** located at 1230 Seaway Dr, Ft Pierce, Fl 34949. The hotel offers waterfront accommodations in a relaxed tropical atmosphere. The Plaza is located on the sand on South Hutchinson Island directly on the Fort Pierce Inlet. Just steps from the water and nearby businesses and attractions, the **Hutchinson Island Plaza Hotel & Suites** offers



something for everyone. To stay in touch with work, friends and family you can enjoy free Wireless Internet Access and 24-hour business center. Reunion guests will surely want to take advantage of the Plaza's proximity to the ocean and jetty as well as the gorgeous inlet beaches. You may also want to rent a fishing pole from the gift shop and head out to the private pier to see if the fish are biting! Each morning, guests will enjoy a Deluxe Continental Breakfast that also features a rotating menu of fresh hot items such as cheese omelets and sausage sandwiches. Relax at the end of the day by the palm tree-flanked, waterfront, seasonally heated pool and hot tub and watch the sunset. All rooms have full or partial water views. Parking is free for those who drive; however, spaces are limited to one car per room occupied.

12:00 noon: Registration Begins and the Hospitality Room will open. The hospitality room will close during the welcome reception.

Thursday May 1, 2014

6:30 – 9:30 AM: Breakfast will be in the hotel restaurant. Eat at your leisure in the hotel restaurant anytime during the restaurant's normal breakfast serving hours, keeping in mind the starting time for the optional tour. *Cost of Thursday's breakfast is included in the room rate, therefore you cannot opt out.*

9:30 AM: Today's Optional tour will take you first to the National UDT/SEAL Museum. Dive into the secret world of Naval Special Warfare at The National Navy SEAL Museum and Memorial. Here you can explore the history of these legendary maritime special operations warriors. Get up close and hands-on with the specialized equipment used by Navy SEAL Teams—from the first operations of their legacy units during World War II to today's high tech, high stakes missions. You will also find rare and unusual artifacts from some of the SEAL's most renowned and dangerous missions.

At the heart of the Museum we honor and support the SEALs and their predecessors for their contribution to our national security. The Museum is situated in proximity of the historic beaches where the first volunteers for Naval Combat Demolition Units and Underwater Demolition Teams, the forefathers of today's SEALs, trained to assault the beaches of Normandy and Southern France in Europe and numerous islands throughout the Pacific; including preparations for the invasion of Japan. After leaving the museum, you'll drive a few miles up the road to Vero Beach and Mulligan's Beach House Restaurant where you will have lunch on your own. After lunch comes one of the highlights of the reunion – a visit to the St Lucie County Historical Museum – home of USS Muliphen artifacts. In addition to USS Muliphen artifacts the museum features a number of permanent exhibits including artifacts from the wreck of the 1715 Spanish Fleet, The Cobb Store, the Gardner House, the fort room reflecting the history of the Seminole Wars and forts, and a Seminole Exhibit. The memorial service will be held at an appropriate place at the museum. There is a minimum of 25 persons for this tour to go.
